theoretical shift accomplished is major claiming that such a view of democracy is capable of replacing the mainstream categories of justice freedom and non domination in their hegemonic function of all encompassing political concepts frega then argues for democracy as the broader normative framework within which to rethink the meaning and forms of associated living in all spheres of personal social economic and political life drawing on diverse traditions of american pragmatism and critical theory as well as tackling political issues which are at the core of contemporary theoretical debates this book invites a rethinking of political theory to one more concerned with the political circumstances of social life rather than remaining confined in the narrowly circumscribed space of a theory of government

the marranos were former jews forced to convert to christianity in spain and portugal and their later descendents despite economic and some political advancement these conversos suffered social stigma and were persecuted by the inquisition in this unconventional history yirmiyahu yovel tells their fascinating story and reflects on what it means for modern forms of identity he describes the marranos as the other within people who both did and did not belong rejected by most jews as renegades and by most veteran christians as jews with impure blood marranos had no definite integral identity yovel argues the judaizers marranos who wished to remain secretly jewish were not actually jews and those marranos who wished to assimilate were not truly integrated as hispano catholics rather mixing jewish and christian symbols and life patterns marranos were typically distinguished by a split identity they also discovered the subjective mind engaged in social and religious dissent and demonstrated early signs of secularity and this worldliness in these ways yovel says the marranos anticipated and possibly helped create many central features of modern western and jewish experience one of yovel s philosophical conclusions is that split identity which the inquisition persecuted and modern nationalism considers illicit is a genuine and inevitable shape of human existence one that deserves recognition as a basic human freedom drawing on historical studies inquisition records and contemporary poems novels treatises and other writings this engaging critical history of the marrano experience is also a profound meditation on dual identities and the birth of modernity

lowell I bennion is legendary in many circles an Ids institute instructor and professor of sociology at the university of utah he was never content simply to quantify social ills or to preach against them but actively set out to correct what he could he founded and directed the teton valley boys ranch served as executive director for the salt lake city community services council and organized other charities his heart was with the underprivileged he detested pharisaism and often quoted biblical passages on the topic adapted to a mormon ear as your treading is upon the poor i hate i despise your f ast days and i will not dwell in your solemn assemblies take thou away from me the noise of thy songs for i will not hear woe unto them that are at ease in zion bennion passed away in 1996 just after this biography was released leaving an enormous void where he had been a beacon to humanitarian and liberation causes in his community
