gallipoli the mere name summons the story of this well known campaign of the first world war

and the story of gallipoli where in august 1915 the allied forces made their last valiant effort against the turks is one of infamous might have beens if only the allies had held out a little longer pushed a little harder had better luck gallipoli might have been the decisive triumph that knocked the ottoman empire out of the first world war but the story is just that author rhys crawley tells us a story not only was the outcome at gallipoli not close but the operation was flawed from the start and an inevitable failure a painstaking effort to set the historical record straight climax at gallipoli examines the performance of the allies mediterranean expeditionary force from the beginning of the gallipoli campaign to the bitter end crawley reminds us that in 1915 the second year of the war the allies were still trying to adapt to a new form of warfare with static defense replacing the maneuver and offensive strategies of earlier british doctrine in the attempt both the mef at gallipoli and the british expeditionary force on the western front aimed for too much and both failed to explain why crawley focuses on the operational level of war in the campaign scrutinizing planning command mobility fire support interservice cooperation and logistics his work draws on unprecedented research into the files of military organizations across the united kingdom and australia the result is a view of the gallipoli campaign unique in its detail and scope as well as in its conclusions a book that looks past myth and distortion to the facts and the truth of what happened at this critical juncture in twentieth century history

the british led mediterranean expeditionary force that attacked the ottoman empire at gallipoli in 1915 was a multi national affair including australian new zealand irish french and indian soldiers ultimately a failure the campaign ended with the withdrawal of the allied forces after less than nine months and the unexpected victory of the ottoman armies and their german allies in britain the campaign led to the removal of churchill from his post as first lord of the admiralty and the abandonment of the plan to attack germany via its soft underbelly in the east thereafter it was largely forgotten on a national level commemorated only in specific localities linked to the campaign in post war turkey by contrast the memory of gallipoli played an important role in the formation of a turkish national identity celebrating both the ordinary soldier and the genius of the republic s first president mustafa kemal the campaign served a similarly important formative role in both australia and new zealand where it is commemorated annually on anzac day for the southern irish meanwhile the bitter memory of service for the king in a botched campaign was forgotten for decades shaped initially by the imperatives of war time and the needs of the grief stricken and the bereft the memory of gallipoli has been re made time and again over the last century for the turks an inspirational victory for many on the allied side a glorious and romantic defeat for others still an episode best forgotten gallipoli has meant different things to different people serving by turns as an occasion of sincere and heartfelt sorrow an opportunity for separatist and feminist protest and a formative influence in the forging of national identities

the battle for gallipoli has been described as one of the world's classic tragedies and in this book the participants of the failed offensive tell their own tragic stories through contemporary accounts and memories recorded later in life

the new zealanders at gallipoli was researched and compiled by major fred waite 21 august 1885 29 august 1952 d s o n z e c m g v d who served with the main body and the n z a division as a staff officer of engineers during the great war during the second world war waite was overseas commissioner for the national patriotic fund board and was appointed an officer of the

order of the british empire for his services in this role in the introduction he wrote these popular histories of new zealand s share in the great war are designed to present to the people of new zealand the inspiring record of the work of our sons and daughters overseas the movements of the anzacs are traced from their various points of departure around new zealand via australia to colombo aden and through the red sea and the suez canal to eventual disembarkation at alexandria egypt after a spell of training in egypt the anzacs were shipped across the mediterranean to the gallipoli peninsula in the dardanelles in northwest turkey with an objective to capturing the peninsula as a prelude to invading turkey and capturing istanbul waite details the landing of the anzacs on 25 april 1915 the many skirmishes and drives to get the upper hand and the eventual evacuation in december 1915 also included are many photographs of the terrain encampments and maps to put the images into context all of which give the reader a good feel for layout and the conditions being experienced by the troops to this day 25 april is celebrated in new zealand and australia as anzac day the dardanelles were known in classical antiquity as the hellespont and in effect forms the continental boundary between europe and asia their importance was recognised as far back as 482bc herodotus tells us that at this time xerxes i of persia the son of darius the great had two pontoon bridges built across the width of the hellespont at abydos in order that his huge army could cross from persia into greece history also tells us they were vital to the defence of constantinople during the byzantine period of history 330ad 1453ad their importance was also recognised by the ottoman empire 1354ad 1922ad which was allied to germany during the great war hence the attempt by the allies to wrest control of the dardanelles from turkey in 1915

dust donkeys and delusion examines and clinically debunks the myth that has grown up around private john simpson kirkpatrick the so called man with the donkey the quintessential australian hero of gallipoli while the various elements of the simpson myth have now become popularly accepted as history dust donkeys and delusion shows clearly based on historical documents both official and unofficial that almost every word ever spoken or written about simpson following his death is false

in the australian psyche the gallipoli campaign is the action on gallipoli peninsula but an important addition to that land campaign was the part played by the australian submarine hmas ae2 the ae2 achieved a daring passage through the dardanelles on 25 april 1915 when anzac troops were landing on the other side at anzac cove the royal and french navies previous attempts at passage had ended in disaster ae2 s mission to run amuck ended after five days in the sea of marmara when it was caught by the turkish sultanhisar torpedo boat after being holed ae2 s captain stoker scuttled the submarine and its crew were saved by sultanhisar s captain ali riza beneath the dardanelles tells ae2 s story from both the australian and turkish perspectives and features extracts from the memoirs of the two captains rarely in military books are both sides of a battle presented so evenly the submarine lay undiscovered on the bottom of the sea until 1998 and awaits its destiny as the largest historical australian relic of the gallipoli campaign the future of ae2 will be newsworthy for years to come and this book makes an important contribution to that story

our friend the enemy is the first detailed history of the gallipoli campaign at anzac since charles bean s official history viewed from both sides of the wire and described in first hand accounts

australian captain herbert layh recounted that as they approached the beach on 25 april that once we were behind cover the turks turned their fire on us and gave us a lively 10 minutes a poor chap next to me was hit three times he begged me to shoot him but luckily for him a fourth bullet got him and put him out of his pain later that day sergeant charles saunders a new zealand engineer described his first taste of battle the turks were entrenched some 50 100 yards from the edge of the face of the gully and their machine guns swept the edges line after line of our men went up some lines didn t take two paces over the crest when down they went to a man and on came another line gunner recep trudal of the turkish 27th regiment wrote of the fierce turkish counter attack on 19 may designed to push the anzac s back into the sea it started at morning prayer call time and then it went on and on never stopped you know there was no break for eating or anything attack was our command that was what the pasha said once he says attack you attack and you either die or you survive
