many subject matter experts are just that subject matter experts not experts in the art of teaching facilitating or designing thousands of authors trainers and speakers have great content but they lack the skills required to convey their content in a way that inspires learners to unleash their brilliance and move the learning to practice they often spend 70 of their time on what they are going to teach and 30 of their time on how when they should be spending 30 on what and 70 on how their instructional techniques
