while involved in the lifting or moving of people you will learn appropriate methods and techniques as well as the basics about your body and spine and how to stay healthy in this book to keep everybody safe this is such an important topic that i have a specialized book purely on manual handling if you feel you require it this book does cover many areas however and includes the important principles of manual handling with the correct information guidance and supervision you will be able to safely and effectively deliver care to a person who has a disability whether they are young or elderly learn and be informed
