Round Characters Complex multidimensional characters with flaws and strengths

Flat Characters Simpler characters who usually represent a specific trait

Dynamic Characters Characters who undergo significant change throughout the story

2 Static Characters Characters who remain essentially the same throughout the story

Digging Deeper Theme Symbolism and Literary Devices These elements add richness and complexity to a story inviting deeper analysis

Theme The central idea or message the author wants to convey Think of it as the underlying meaning or purpose of the story Themes often explore universal human experiences like love loss hope or the struggle for power

How to identify themes Look for recurring patterns motifs and symbols throughout the story

Symbolism When an object person or event represents something beyond its literal meaning It often serves to convey abstract ideas or emotions Examples A dove often symbolizes peace a rose symbolizes love and a skull symbolizes death

Literary Devices Techniques authors use to enhance their writing and create a stronger impact on the reader Some common literary devices include

Metaphor A comparison between two unlike things without using like or as

Simile A comparison between two unlike things using like or as

Personification Giving human qualities to inanimate objects or animals

Imagery Descriptive language that appeals to the senses

Foreshadowing Hints or clues about future events

Irony A contrast between expectation and reality
