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der autor zeichnet auf einer breiten quellengrundlage ein lebendiges bild der größten deutschen gewerkschaft vor 1933 an der schnittstelle zwischen arbeits arbeiter und arbeiterbewegungsforschung der zentrale ort gewerkschaftlicher entwicklung war dabei der betrieb mit dem alltäglichen kontakt zu den belegschaften die geschichte des deutschen metallarbeiter verbandes gewinnt dadurch eine historische dynamik wieder die den weg der organisation nicht allein politischen herausforderungen überschreibt sondern das gewerkschaftliche gestaltungspotential gleichberechtigt einbezieht und auf diese weise eine gewerkschaft im fluss abseits der klassenbildungsklischees entwirft

this book analyzes how a sizable group of gennan workers came to support communism and how they in turn influenced the emergence and development of the german communist party kpd in its fonnative period as a mass party it reconstructs the interaction between a party and

the constituency to which it appealed within the constraints and opportunities set by social structures economic conditions and political competitors this interaction revolved around the elaboration and implementation of a specific concept of revolutionary politics and this study investigates both the rise of the kpd as a mass party and its failure to set off a socialist revolution in the early 1920s in light of the contradictory ways german workers responded to its revolutionary strategy when i began to study the kpd in the mid 1970s scholarly works in the west portrayed a party so out of touch with the realities of german life from 1918 to 1933 that its history was a litany of political mistakes that led from crisis to catastrophe the kpd was dominated by the foreign policy interests of the soviet union by factional disputes and personal rivalries among the leadership by an authoritarian centralized party structure that stifled rank and file initiative and imposed a party line determined in moscow and berlin and by a rigid ideology largely irrelevant to trends in german economy society and politics with at best compensatory value for a minority of the most impoverished workers

richard müller a leading figure of the german revolution in 1918 is unknown today as the operator and unionist who represented berlin s metalworkers he was main organiser of the revolutionary stewards a clandestine network that organised a series of mass strikes between 1916 and 1918 with strong support in the factories the revolutionary stewards were the driving force of the revolution by telling müller s story this study gives a very different account of the revolutionary birth of the weimar republic using new archival sources and abandoning the traditional focus on the history of political parties ralf hoffrogge zooms in on working class politics on the shop floor and its contribution to social change first published in german by karl dietz verlag as richard müller der mann hinter der november revolution berlin 2008 this english edition was completely revised for the english speaking audience and contains new sources and recent literature

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
