this book examines sezs from a political economy perspective both to dissect the incentives of governments zone developers and exporters and to uncover both the hidden costs and untapped potential of zone policies costs include misallocated resources the encouragement of rent seeking and distraction of policy makers from more effective reforms however the zones also have several unappreciated benefits they can change the politics of a country by generating a transition from a system of rent seeking to one of liberalized open markets in revealing the hidden promise of sezs this book shows how the sez model of development can succeed in the future

with society s continuous development and the increasing demands of a growing human population the concept of special economy has emerged as a new theory in relation to animal agriculture the rearing and utilization of special economic animals which refer to artificially domesticated animals for economic value have gained attention worldwide in different parts of the world over 50 species of these special economic animals are reared for commercial purposes and as a valuable food resource these include a variety of special breeds of livestock and poultry such as sika deer red deer yak silky chickens pigeons and ostriches fur animals like fox raccoon dog and mink are raised for their pelts while rare birds honeybees and silkworms are bred for their unique contributions additionally other valuable insects such as the black soldier fly also hold significance within the realm of special economic animals however the special economic animal industry faces complex pressures and challenges

investment in manufacturing and services and its aim to increase and diversify exports of goods and services sezs are industrial enclaves clusters within a country that receive certain incentives and business facilitation benefits that are not generally available to the rest of the country to facilitate private and foreign investment in sezs india introduced the sez policy in 2000 which was followed by the sez act in 2005 after ten years under the act india now has one of the largest number of approved sezs in the world and its sez policy remains heatedly debated with a number of studies arguing both for and against it given this background the book also identifies the challenges faced by sezs in india and offers policy recommendations on how to make the sezs an engine for india s economic growth and development that can more effectively link the country s manufacturing and services sectors to global value chains

in 2005 india s special economic zones bill was passed amidst a wider push for economic liberalisation and growth the new special economic zones act specifically provided for the establishment of spatially bounded economic enclaves to be governed by a separate legal and regulatory framework while proponents have lauded this move citing the growth and employment generating potential of special economic zones sezs others have not been so enthused specifically

detractors have voiced concern that these enclaves of excellence do not deliver their professed benefits cause harm through land acquisition and undermine democratic accountability if india s sez scheme does undermine accountability then this has potentially significant implications for the quality of india s democracy however it is not obvious that this is so in light of cases such as goa where popular agitation led to the cancellation of the state entire sez programme it seems we are presented with an incredibly varied picture as a result this thesis asks why have some citizens been able to exact accountability for special economic zone related grievances whilst others have not in order to answer this i investigate five sezs combining within case and cross case analysis in an effort to identify factors which may explain this variance saliently this thesis has facilitated the creation of new theory finding that the state machinery often serves as a broker of accountability determining who successfully exacts accountability and who does not i argue that this poses a direct challenge to notions of democratic accountability which are commonly couched in the language of citizen empowerment and popular control
