the matrix method is one of many ways to approach a literature review it was created by judith garrard when she was preparing nih grants and is intended to teach students how to read a paper organize the review using the matrix method analyze it and create a narrative synthesis this method is particularly useful in the health sciences review is usually the initial step for a proposal for independent scientific study often a master s project or doctoral dissertation and traditionally done under the guidance of faculty or a mentor though judy s background is not in nursing the adoptions are primarily in graduate

nursing programs the text is not intended as a resource for developing academic writing skills it provides a system for organizing and conducting a literature review and develops research literacy skills
