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child hunger and human rights international governance applies the human rights theory of legal

obligation to the problem of child malnutrition and investigates whether duty bearers have fulfilled their obligations to protect respect and provide this book includes moral economic political and legal components to the research on the child's right to be free from hunger using two methods of investigation the first a historical comparative method based on the systematic analysis of the content of historical materials government documents policy statements state budgets newspaper reports and other public records and the second is statistical analysis apodaca investigates beyond the suffering deformities and deaths of children to child malnutrition resulting in reduced physical and mental development threatening the child's life opportunities the prospects of further generations and the growth of the economy examining the connection between governmental agricultural economic and financial policies international donor policies and transnational corporate voluntary codes of conduct affecting child malnutrition rates this book will be of interest to policy makers activists students and scholars of human rights social justice international ethics development international relations and law

the global industrial complex systems of domination is a groundbreaking collection of essays by a diverse set of leading scholars who examine the entangled and evolving global array of corporate state structures of hegemonic power what the editors refer to as the power complex that was first analyzed by c wright mills in his 1956 classic work the power elite in this new volume edited by steven best richard kahn anthony j nocella ii and peter mclaren the power complex is conceived as co constituted interdependent and imbricated systems of domination spreading insidiously on a global level the transnational institutional relationships of the power complex combine the logics of capitalist exploitation and profits and industrialist norms of efficiency control and mass production while some have begun to analyze these institutional complexes as separate entities this book is unique in analyzing them as overlapping mutually enforcing systems that operate globally and which will undoubtedly frame the macro narrative of the 21st century and perhaps beyond the global industrial complex a grand power complex of complexes thus poses one of the most formidable challenges to the sustainability of planetary democracy freedom and peace today but there can be no serious talk of opposition to it until it is more popularly named and understood the global industrial complex aims to be a foundational contribution to this emerging educational and political project

this book recognizes that any attempt to reduce hunger requires a sound understanding of which people are affected it differentiates between food shortage regional food scarcity food poverty

inadequate household food supplies and food deprivation individual malnutrition in order to identify the causes of hunger and recommend ways to effectively target interventions it also focuses on a critical second question how do we know who the hungry are the authors explain commonly used means of measuring hunger the assumptions embedded in these measures and what can and cannot be concluded from the evidence they examine how rules for food distribution operate under normal versus crisis conditions the shortage poverty deprivation framework is designed to call attention to hunger even when food is abundant as well as to learn how hunger is avoided even when food is scarce with many tools in place for combating hunger the book draws attention to the policies that are working and to the individuals households and communities that are underserved the book refines common thinking about the underlying causes of hunger by examining who are most affected

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
