complete level 1 is a faster paced version of levels 1a and 1b that gets to staff reading more quickly perfect for a student who is 8 or older or for a younger beginner with great musical aptitude this course is most effective when used under the direction of a piano teacher or experienced musician

faber piano adventures this book provides a collection of effective pieces to be used in conjunction with the lesson book however teachers will find that the creative appealing pieces in this book make an ideal supplement with many other piano methods as well contents include allegro in a major appalachian trail bearcat boogie come back to sorrento the danube waves gypsy prayer mazurka in g minor poetic theme and variations simple gifts st anthony s chorale the swan and more

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Alfred's Basic Prep Course Levels A through F was written to answer a demand for a course of piano study designed for students who are five years old and up. This course offers a careful introduction of fundamentals music that fits comfortably under the young student's normal hand span plus constant reinforcement all leading to results beyond those generated by other piano methods. After Lesson Book D the student may progress to Prep Course Lesson Book E or choose to go directly into the faster paced Level 2 of Alfred's Basic Piano Library. The complete Prep Course consists of six books Levels A through F.

This easy step by step method emphasizes correct playing habits and note reading through interval recognition. Lesson Book Level 1A begins by teaching basic keyboard topography and fluent recognition of white key names in relation to black keys. It focuses on simple rhythms and prepares students for intervallic reading with entertaining songs that focus on same stepping up and stepping down. It then introduces lines and space notes in treble and bass clefs, melodic and harmonic intervals of 2nds, 3rds, 4ths and 5ths and graduates to reading on the grand staff. It also introduces the flat and sharp signs. This course is most effective when used under the direction of a piano teacher or experienced musician. Faber Piano Adventures Book B of the Faber's Method for the young beginner moves the student into staff reading. Music notation is explored through stepwise directional reading, pattern recognition and changing hand positions all in the context of engaging songs, games and creative exploration at the piano, maintaining the child centered philosophy of the series. The Friends at the Piano from the A books introduce students to the music of two new composer friends: Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart and Ludwig van Beethoven. Classic themes share the stage with

contemporary pop and jazz sounds for young ears to absorb and enjoy the book b audio presents a vibrant mix of sounds from boogie to beethoven the tracks serve as a listening resource which educates and as accompaniment tracks for play along audio is accessed online using the unique code inside the book and can be streamed or downloaded the audio files include playback a multi functional audio player that allows you to slow down audio without changing pitch set loop points change keys and pan left or right

being sent for piano lessons was probably the single worst thing that could have happened in my young life but thanks to an exceptional lady and piano teacher named florence powers i wound up unexpectedly becoming a professional piano player here are some curious things about the piano that i picked up along the way playing the piano has got to be one of life s greatest treasures in my estimation there are few other activities that can even begin to compare with the ability to play this amazing instrument as you can probably guess i have the highest regard for those individuals who have mastered the art of playing the piano some performers have taken the art to a very high level often out of the reach of most players but my aim here is to present a simple accessible approach on learning how to listen to or how to approach playing the piano for one s own pleasure first and foremost this self centered idea doesn t necessarily imply being selfish but it probably does require a slight adjustment to one s priorities however if you can get around this inconvenience the possibilities are sitting right there in front of you and all you have to do is reach out and take my aim here is to demystify the piano for both listeners or those who wish to learn how to get started in learning how play this amazing instrument in any event i feel that pleasure can be derived by having a wider understanding as just what the piano actually is and while a book such as this one may be helpful to those who wish to learn to play the piano there is no substitute for a live teacher however it s extremely important to find a teacher that can fulfill one s personal musical taste and ambition there is much involved if a student wishes to become a proficient music reader thus having a good teacher is essential to success in this area take your time in finding the right one and good luck however before looking at the piano it s also important to establish what kind of music one is interested in whether for listening or performing for purposes of this book i have arbitrarily broken it down into four major forms classical standards popular and jazz classical leads

the list as the music that has been around longer much longer than the other two forms of music it represents the foundation of all of today's music much of it is seriously challenging to play and requires years of dedicated practice at the concert level olympic style discipline prevails as the techniques of performance far surpasses the scope of this book be that as it may classical music has an abundance of priceless melodies that can be played in a simplified manner while still retaining their pure magic for listeners and pianists music operates on principles that were founded in the past 600 years they carry with them an enormous amount of human cultural genius including the invention of equal temperament
