basic facilities for guidance and counseling like offices and reference materials teachers in charge of guidance and counseling are overloaded with their teaching subjects and emphasis is put on attainment of good mean grades it is recommended that there is urgent need for the school administration to prioritize counseling services of all categories of learners as they go hand in hand with holistic development of the learners the ministry of education should put disciplinary measures against school administrators who do not implement viable and sustainable guidance and counseling services that cater for all learners in secondary schools
