acquire design skills as they experience the activity of design by doing design projects it is equally suitable for use in project based first year courses formal engineering design courses and capstone project courses

the call for science curriculum reform has been made over and over again for much of the twentieth century arguments have been made that the content of the curriculum is not appropriate for meeting the individual and social needs of people living in the modern world that the curriculum has become overstuffed with topics and does not serve students especially well and above all that the curriculum does not generate the student learning it is expected to produce the latest volume in a continuing series of publications from the aaas designed to reform science education designs for science literacy presupposes that curriculum reform must be considerably more extensive and fundamental than the tinkering with individual courses and subjects that has been going on for decades designs deals with the critical issues involved in assembling sound instructional materials into a new coherent k 12 whole the book pays special attention to the need to link science oriented studies to the arts and humanities and also proposes how to align the curriculum with an established set of learning goals while preserving the american tradition of local responsibility for the curriculum itself if fundamental curriculum reform is ever to occur a new process for creating alternatives will have to be developed designs for science literacy provides the groundwork for such a process

design as future making brings together leading international designers scholars and critics to address ways in which design is shaping the future the contributors share an understanding of design as a practice that with its focus on innovation and newness is a natural ally of futurity ultimately the choices made by designers are understood here as choices about the kind of world we want to live in design as future making locates design in a space of creative and critical reflection examining the expanding nature of practice in fields such as biomedicine sustainability digital crafting fashion architecture urbanism and design activism the authors contextualize design and its affects within issues of social justice environmental health political agency education and the right to pleasure and play collectively they make the case that as an integrated mode of thought and action design is intrinsically social and deeply political

an exploration of the parallel development of product and graphic design from the 18th century to the 21st the effects of mass production and consumption man made industrial materials and extended lines of communication are also discussed

mr glegg writes about the adventure of inventing where to begin how to think about a problem what principles to apply in tackling it choosing between one possible design and another and so on he takes the reader through each of these stages in turn illuminating his discussion with often highly entertaining examples from his own wide experience as an inventor consulting engineer company director and university teacher although he here adopts a more systematic approach than in his earlier book the design of design mr glegg s evident enjoyment of engineering is still apparent and is communicated to the reader it is a book that will be especially helpful to the young designer who lacks experience and self confidence while also appealing to the old hand who will find that he still has something fresh to learn from it
