relations with belfast were destabilised with the emergence of new social and political forces in northern ireland and the recurrence of sectarian violence the department of external affairs proved initially unable to respond comprehensively to this new environment in northern ireland which was the precursor to the outbreak of the troubles in 1969 improved economic and political relations with london were affected by local and international economic difficulties and also as a consequence of events in northern ireland at the united nations superpower politics constrained irish attempts to follow up the success of the 1968 nuclear non proliferation treaty with a major policy initiative on the financing of international peacekeeping missions
