analyses a number of key texts including kawabata yasanari s sleeping beauties 1961 enchi fumiko s female masks 1958 and imamura sho hei s vengeance is mine 1979 consequently through using concepts of social trauma dissociation failed mourning revenge and narrative memory this book sheds new light on the psychological aftereffects and transgenerational legacies of trauma depicted in japanese works trauma dissociation and re enactment in japanese literature and film will be of interest to students and scholars of japanese literature and cinema as well as those interested in japanese history and trauma studies
