changes associated with aging and the needs of the older adult aging concerns are covered in one chapter and are highlighted throughout the text this edition provides current information that makes the previous edition out of date i would recommend this text for beginning critical care nurses and for undergraduate nursing students for its coverage of advanced pathophysiological concepts
