how did the gospel of mark come to exist and how was the memory of jesus shaped by the experiences of the earliest christians for centuries biblical scholars examined texts as history literature theology or even as story curiously absent however has been attention to processes of collective memory in the creation of biblical texts drawing on modern explorations of social memory sandra huebenthal presents a model for reading biblical texts as collective memories she demonstrates that the gospel of mark is a text evolving from collective narrative memory based on recollections of jesus s life and teachings huebenthal investigates the principles and structures of how groups remember and how their memory is structured and presented in the case of mark s gospel this includes examining which image of jesus as well as which authorial self image this text as memory constructs reading mark s gospel as a text from collective memory serves less as a key to unlock questions about the historical jesus and more as an examination of memory about him within a particular community providing a new and important framework for interpreting the

earliest canonical gospel in context

this unique contribution to markan studies reads mark s story of jesus from a postcolonial perspective it proposes that mark need not necessarily be treated in an oversimplified polarity as an anti or pro colonial discourse instead it may be treated as a postcolonial discourse i e as a hybrid discourse that accommodates and disrupts both the native jewish and the roman colonial discourses of power it shows that mark accommodates itself into a strategic third space in between the variegated native jewish and the roman colonial discourses in order to enunciate its own voice as an ambivalent and hybrid discourse it mimics and mocks accommodates and disrupts both the jewish as well as the roman colonial voices the portrait of jesus in mark which samuel shows to be encoding also the portrait of a community exhibits a colonial postcolonial conundrum which can neither be damned as pro nor be praised as anti colonial in nature instead the portrait of jesus in mark may be appreciated as a strategic essentialist and transcultural hybrid in which the claims of difference and the desire for transculturality are both contradictorily present and visible in showing such a portrait and invoking a complex discursive strategy mark as the discourse of a subject community is not alone or unique in the graeco roman world a number of discourses historical creative novelistic and apocalyptic of the subject greek and jewish communities in the eastern mediterranean under the imperium of rome from the second century bee to the end of the first century ce exhibit very similar postcolonial traits which one may add to be not far from the postcolonial traits of a number of postcolonial communities of our time

did mark write his gospel in response to roman imperial propaganda surrounding the destruction of jerusalem adam winn helps us rediscover how mark might have been read by christians in rome during the aftermath of this cataclysmic event he introduces us to the imperial propaganda of the flavian emperors and excavates the markan text for themes that address the roman imperial setting

challenging the view that mark was written as late as 65 75 ce james crossley argues instead for a date thirty years earlier basing this conclusion on the internal evidence supplied by the gospel itself after a concise overview of the external evidence the date of mark s gospel goes on to critically examine the arguments which place the writing of mark around the time of the jewish war suggesting alternative historical contexts this leads to a discussion of modern literary criticism of the gospel as a whole outlining the main approaches and their protagonists crossley then shows that while the synoptic gospels all portray jesus as a law observant jew mark in particular writes assuming that he observed biblical law fully arguing that such an assumption could only be made at a time when christianity was largely law observant the author offers a comprehensive examination of the evidence on laws provided in the gospel concluding that this dates the composition of mark to no later than the mid 40s
